If its planning application is successful, Chopstix Noodle Bar is hoping to open in the centre of Cambridge, replacing Phones4U on Market Street.

Lincolnshire-based North Shoes has opened in the former Campkins camera shop at 11 Rose Crescent, creating 5 jobs.

A new global headquarters for fruit and flower firm MMUK Ltd is set to become the first large-scale commercial building on the former Alconbury airfield development site. Around 500 jobs will be created at Alconbury Campus with the construction of nearly 32,000 sqm of commercial floor space, including new headquarters and production facilities.

Work has started on a major expansion of Ely's Lancaster Way Business Park. Nine new units for small and start-up businesses are being built on the site, which is owned by Grovemere Property Ltd. It is expected the expansion will create between 30 and 50 new jobs

- Metalcraft, of Chatteris Business Park, in Chatteris, has taken on 10 apprentices after securing a £47 million contract with the Sellafield nuclear site.
- May Farm Mushroom facility, near Littleport, was officially opened on October 21 by Tesco's commercial director. The new farm created 300 new full time jobs and reduced food miles through bringing production to the UK for products that were previously sourced from Europe.
